Ray Ramirez was born in, December of 1945, in Montebello, California. He attended local schools and graduated from Montebello High School in 1963. He attended East Los Angeles Junior College for 1 year and then volunteered for the United States Army in September of 1964.

He received his Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Ord, CA. While stationed at Fort Bliss, TX, in 1965, he volunteered for the 101st Airborne Division and upon completion of Airborne Training in September of 1965 was assigned to the 1st Battalion (Airborne), 501st Infantry and worked in the Operations Section.
